

MUTTI, 1200 NEW HIRES FOR THE 2023 TOMATO PROCESSING CAMPAIGN

- The company is to hire 450 workers in Montechiarugolo (PR), 400 in Collecchio (PR) and 350 in Oliveto
 Citra (SA). They will be employed from July to September, the most important period of the year for
 the company.
- As well as seasonal workers, Mutti is also looking for students, such as graduates of industrial and professional technical schools in the areas of mechanics, electrical engineering and electronics.
 These are joined by specialist technical profiles such as quality control analysts and samplers.
- The company is offering seasonal contracts.

4 May 2023, Montechiarugolo (PR) – **Mutti**, European leader in the tomato product market, **has announced that it is recruiting 1200 new hires** from **July to September** to work on the Group's production and administrative activities at its three plants. More specifically, **450 workers are being hired at Montechiarugolo (PR), 400 at Collecchio (PR) and 350 at Oliveto Citra (SA).**

The recruitment drive coincides with the **tomato processing campaign**, a key period for the company in which, over the space of about 75 summer days from mid-July to the end of September, it processes the raw materials produced by over 800 families of Italian farmers, using only tomatoes picked during their natural growth cycle.

As well as traditional seasonal workers, Mutti is also looking for profiles to cover specialist roles such as *quality control analyst* and *tomato field sampler*. The other profiles sought this year also include graduates of industrial and professional technical schools in the fields of mechanics, electrical engineering and electronics, who will be tasked with monitoring machinery and managing complex systems in the areas of industrial automation and robotics.

Applications are already open and the company is offering seasonal contracts.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- They must be of legal working age
- Available from 1 July to 30 September
- Own their own car
- Be willing to work in shifts (including Sundays, bank holidays and nights).

Montechiarugolo (PR) is the historic business headquarters of the Group which has gradually expanded to meet all the needs of its consumers. The Oliveto Citra plant (SA) processes typical southern Italian specialities, such as the plum tomato and the cherry tomato. Finally, in November 2017 Mutti acquired the CO.PAD.OR plant in Collecchio, setting up the new company Pomodoro 43044 Srl which was subsequently merged with Mutti SpA as of 1 January 2021.

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
